#### **Meet Conditions**

- 1. This event will be swum **Short Course**. The pool depth is 2.4m. Care is required when diving. Feet first entry during warm-up. Diving is permitted in lanes 0 and 9, deep end only, for the last 10 minutes of warm-up.
- 2. The meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA and local rules, with over the top starts.
- 3. Marshalling will be next to the toddler pool.
- 4. All events will be swum as mixed races, slowest to fastest.
- No times (NT) will be accepted.
- 6. Age is at 28 November 2020. **Open to SNZ registered club & competitive swimmers** 12 years and under only.
- 7. Classified para swimmers (including those with provisional classification) are eligible to compete at this meet. Para swimmers are requested to report to the Meet Referee prior to the warm-up.
- 8. Maximum meet length is 2.5 hours.
- 9. Entries and payments will be via the SNZ Database. **Entries close at 23:59.59 on Sunday 22 November 2020.** Late entries will not be accepted.
- 10. Entry fees are \$8 per event, payment online by Credit or Debit Card.
- 11. Raumati Swimming Club Inc. is GST Registered No 55-204-241.
- 12. Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 events.
- 13. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after entries close.
- 14. All scratchings close at midday on the Friday 27 November 2020. Spectator programmes will be emailed to clubs and available online at <a href="www.raptors.nz">www.raptors.nz</a> later that day. No programmes will be available for purchase at the meet.
- 15. Entry and programmes for nominated coaches & team managers will be; 1–10 Swimmers [2], 11-20 [4], 21-35+ [6]. Entry for spectators is free.
- 16. Clubs are required to provide at least 1 IOT and 2 timekeepers. Please send names to <a href="mailto:officials@raptors.nz">officials@raptors.nz</a> no later than Monday 23 November 2020. Clubs providing officials will be given preference where training is available.
- 17. Strapping on a swimmer must be sighted and approved by the Referee and supported by a doctor's/physio's certificate prior to the meet.
- 18. Protests must be submitted to the referee, in writing, on the protest form by the team manager only within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event. This needs to be accompanied, in cash, by the \$100.00 protest fee.
- 19. The Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
- 20. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swimming Wellington or host Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
- 21. The Organisers reserve the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme.
