Conditions of Entry:

1. The meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA and Local Rules.
2. Self-marshalling will operate.
3. Swimmers must be financial Club or Competitive members of Swimming New Zealand and of the Gold Coast clubs noted above.
4. Entry is restricted to those swimmers aged 12 and over. Swimmers must be at least 12 years of age as on Saturday 29th February 2019.
5. Meet organiser is c/- Vicky Gibbs, Race Secretary, Tawa Swimming Club (021 104 3357).
6. To be eligible to swim the 800m, a swimmer must have an official 400m time; to be eligible to swim the 1500m, a swimmer must have an official 800m time.
7. Entry is restricted to one event. An event fee of \$10 is payable on entry via the SNZ database. Pool entry (as per <https://wellington.govt.nz/recreation/get-active-with-us/swimming-pools/charges>) must also be paid on the door.
8. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under the IPC Swimming rules and must present their classification card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of the meet.
9. Entries will be via the SNZ Database. Entries close at 23:59.59 (midnight) on Sunday 23rd February 2020. Late entries not accepted.
10. All swimmers entering this meet must provide an official or person to assist with running the meet as required. Please indicate your availability by emailing officials@swimtawa.org.nz, thank you.
11. The Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet.
12. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
13. Entries will be reviewed on closing. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the program if necessary, to restrict entries, and/or to close entries early. Entry priority will be given to Tawa Swimming Club swimmers. Clubs will be notified if there is a need to reduce the number of entries.
14. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swimming Wellington or host Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
