PCA SUMMER SWIM TRAINING CAMP 2013

The Summer Swim Camp will be held in Rotorua from the 7th Jan – 13th Jan 2013. The swimmers will be staying at Rotorua YHA in a self contained unit with camp parents over seeing their care. The coach will be staying in the YHA Hostel. We had to change the location of the accommodation as the Rotorua Thermal Holiday Park has been sold and their lodge closed.

Swim training will be undertaken for 2hrs twice a day in the geothermal heated 50m swimming pool at the Rotorua aquatic centre. The YHA Unit is next door to the park where the aquatic centre is situated, so the swimmers will be able to walk to training. The camp is primary for swim training for the Wellington Long Course Championships at the end of January, so swimming is the main focus. However, we aim to have some team building activities. The swimmers will be expected to stick to the camp routine and undertake some housekeeping duties as requested on a rota ie: washing up, keeping their room tidy etc. We also hope that the swimmers have fun and enjoy themselves, this is a great opportunity for some fantastic training in a supportive and great environment.

Cost will be around \$500-600 per swimmer and will include, transport, all food, coaching and pool entry. Swimmers attending the camp will be expected to help out with some fund raising activities to be confirmed in order to raise money towards the camp. Any money raised will come off the overall total reducing the costs of the camp for every swimmer attending.

Qualifying criteria for the camp is as follows;

- Member of Senior, Orcas and / or swordfish squad
- Club swimmers with Wellington qualifying times
- Age 10 and over at the time of the camp.

This is a major competition with over 300 swimmers from 32 clubs all over the South Island. Both swimmers were competing in the 10/under class against some tough competition, including medallists from the National Juniors.

They both swam superbly, with results as follows: Jack – 11 Golds (Free 50, 100, 200 Back 50, 100, Breast 50, 100, 200, Fly 50, IM 100, 200). He got PBs in every event, broke his previous Wellington record in the 50 Free and broke the club record for the 200IM.

Sophie - 8 Golds (Free 50, 100 Back 50, 100, 200, Fly 100, IM 100, 200); Silver Free 100; Bronze Fly 50. She achieved 5 PBs.

Jack was top 10/under boy and the 2nd overall swimmer at the competition and Sophie was the top 10/under girl and 7th overall in the competition.

Overall the club came 2nd out of 19 in the 10 swimmers and fewer club category, the club that won had 10 swimmers competing!

CLUB SWIMMING CAPS

At the April meeting the Committee agreed on a new policy for issue of club caps which will come into effect from the start of the 2012/13 subscription year:

1. That all members are given a club cap for the 2012/2013 year on receipt of subscription payment.
2. Caps will be replaced if they break or split providing the old cap is returned.
3. For the future new members will be given a cap on receipt of their subs.
4. Swimmers loosing their club cap will need to buy a replacement.

JULY SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

During the school holidays Monday and Friday club nights will be devoted to distance badge swimming.

For those new to the club, PCA has distance badges swimmers can achieve by completing a distance without stopping, The distances covered are 25m (one length) 50m, 100m, 200m, 400, 800, and 1500m. Once a swimmer has completed all these distances they can move on to swimming 1 kilometre (40 lengths) for a time. The club has various ribbons to reward swimmers for the times achieved.

Those swimming up to 400m metres should come at 6pm, while those swimming longer distances are to come at 7pm. To help these evenings run smoothly Eileen and Viv need help from parents counting laps and timing the 1k swimmers. Please note, swimmers may need to wait their turn if the lanes are full, so everyone has the opportunity to achieve their goals

- Swimmers in the group can express interest (again this is not automatic) in remaining in the Tadpoles for the following term. A swimmer's time in the Tadpole may be limited to two terms.
- It is envisaged that swimmers will continue to swim on Mondays and/or Sunday's with their normal club coach while they are in the Tadpoles.
- After 'graduating' from the Tadpoles swimmers may choose to move into one of Alex's other groups – the Swordfish or the Penguins, or continue to swim in the volunteer coaches lanes.
