SATURDAY MORNING TRAINING FOR THE SENIOR SQUAD AT PORIRUA POOL

Due to a change in the pricing structure at the Porirua Pool, Nevill has cancelled all Saturday morning training sessions from the Saturday 13th February until further notice..

The council are now working to a cost recovery basis which means when the pool is hired outside normal public hours the hirer is charged extra to cover the staff who are on duty. These extra costs now make these sessions totally uneconomic and as such these sessions have been cancelled. This does not effect the Mon – Fri am and pm sessions, only the early Saturday morning session.

Swimmers will now be able to attend any sessions from Monday to Friday.

We had a large team of 33 swimmers participating at the recent Wellington Summer Long Course Champs. Well done to everyone that qualified especially to a few swimmers that had qualified for their first time. Our fantastic team performed really well with great results.

Standout performer was Ben Walsh who won an amazing 10 Golds, 4 Silvers and 1 Bronze and the prize for Swimmer of the Meet for 12 year old boys.

Mia Uluilalata won her first ever Wellington Champs Gold medal in the 9 years 100 back, along with a silver in the 50 back.

Josh Walsh and Nicole Mitchell were our other gold medalists with Nicole's win also gaining her the Open 200 metre breaststroke female swimmer of the Championship. Josh Walsh was second in the Swimmer of the Meet for 10 year old boys.
