During the School holidays club sessions will be devoted to swimming for distance badges.

For those new to the club, we have distance badges swimmers can achieve by completing a distance without stopping, The distances covered are 25m (one length) 50m, 100m, 200m, 400, 800, and 1500m. Once a swimmer has completed all these distances they can move on to swimming 1 kilometre (40 lengths) for a time. The club has various ribbons to reward swimmers for the times achieved.

Those swimming up to 400m metres should come at 7pm, while those swimming longer distances should come at 7.45pm. As we only have three lanes available swimmers should be prepared to wait if the lanes are full. Squad swimmers are welcome to come join in.

## **DISQUALIFICATIONS**

Below is a very brief summary of the most common reasons why swimmers may be disqualified.

• False Start – diving in or moving on the starting block before the staters signal FREESTYLE

- Failed to touch at the end of the race or at the turn. At the turn swimmers are required to touch the end with at least one part of their body.
- Walked a swimmer may stop in a freestyle race, but must not take a step.

#### **BACKSTROKE**

- Pushed off the wall at the turn on their tummy.
- Off their back at the finish (over 90 degrees) This also applied if the swimmer is doing a touch turn.
- For a tumble turn the swimmer must not glide into the wall. They must judge the distance very carefully.
- Swimmers must have two hands on the block at the start.

#### **BREASTSTROKE**

- Alternating arm and feet movements.
- Wrong kick feet not turned out.
- One handed touch at the finish and for all turns swimmers must touch with two hands at the same time.
- Failure to break the surface with the head during each stroke
- Two strokes under water at the turn one stroke, is permitted.

## **BUTTERFLY**

- Arms not synchronised or brought over the water.
- Under water recovery. This applies at the turn and finish if the swimmer has started their arm pull then they need to complete it.

- Incorrect kick feet not staying together.
- One handed touch as for breaststroke.

For Freestyle, Backstroke and Butterfly (in individual races and during relays) swimmers must surface from a dive or turn within 15 metres.

#### **MEDLEY**

- Incorrect order (Fly, Back, Breast and Free)
- Incorrect turn or finish for all strokes the turn and finish rules for that stroke apply.
- Incorrect stroke and/or kick

#### **RELAY**

- Incorrect order in medley relay (Back, Breast, Fly and Free)
- Incorrect turn or finish
- Incorrect stroke or kick
- Starting early before the previous swimmer has touched the wall.
- All swimmers (except the last swimmer must exit the pool immediately after they have swum their leg.

This is a very brief summary of Swimming Rules, and may go some way to helping swimmers and their parents understand why they may have been disqualified at the Club Champs. If your child was disqualified they should discuss the DQ with their coach to ensure they are better prepared for next time.

## **Swim Meets and Entry Instructions**

#### Swim Meet notices:

These will be displayed on the notice board at Cannons Creek pool plus at the Aquatic Centre in the PCA cupboard which needs to be opened and accessible at each session.

Also in the monthly newsletters there is a table of upcoming events. The newsletters are handed out to as many members as possible plus can be viewed via our website: www.swimporirua.co.nz

#### **Meet Entry Instructions:**

For GOLD COAST MEETS, (and in-house club events) *swimmers* need to write their name clearly on the entry form provided and tick the events they wish to enter. Please be aware of any entry criteria. *Parents* need to help with duty requirements as necessary (time keeping, door, refreshments etc) and write their name on the sheet provided.

For ALL OTHER MEETS, swimmers must complete the PCA Meet Entry Form and place in the Race Entry box with payment. At CCK pool the race entry box is the green letterbox <u>not</u> the black box on the wall, and at the Aquatic Centre it is held at reception. There is a supply of envelopes at both locations if required.

The PCA Meet Entry Form will be available on the website and a supply will also be available on the notice boards

<u>PARENTS</u>, you will be required to help out from time to time with our club's official duties at the meets your child is swimming at. (eg. time keeping, IOT, door, refreshments....). When required our Officials Co-ordinator (Terry Laws) will contact you requesting your assistance.

Please ensure all entries are in **before** the closing date that has been written on the top of the meet flyer. Please be aware that the closing date for entries will differ than those seen on websites to allow time for processing entries and payments.

Late entries and/or entries without money will not be accepted.

Listed later in this newsletter are the names of all those who have qualified for this meet. This is a huge list – probably the most PCA has ever had qualified for a meet like this. Hopefully most swimmers will take up the opportunity to swim at this meet. This is one of the biggest meets on Swim Wellington's calendar and gives our developing swimmers a chance to see Wellington's top swimmers in action.
