

Club Swimming COVID-19 Alert Level 2 from 10 September 2021

Club swimming will start this week from Friday 10th September.

Under level 2 there can only be four swimmers in a lane.

Monday and Friday; Session times have been reduced to 30 minutes on Monday and Friday – classes will be at 6pm, 6.30pm, 7pm and 7.30pm. The coaches are hoping that some 6pm swimmers will aim to swim at 6.30pm, and some of those who swim at 6.45pm will choose to swim at a later time.

Sunday morning; Sessions will be at 8am, 8.45am or 9.30am. As there is no learn to swim we will run an extra club group at 9.30am, therefore we need some 8.45am swimmers to come along a bit later for the 9.30am session.

If the lanes are full then swimmers will need to wait until the next session time, and unfortunately that may be waiting outside as there is only to be 50 in the building. Parents we will do need your co-operation here – please stay in your car or ‘drop and run.’

Swimmers should arrive in their togs and it is suggested for a quick turn around go home in their togs.

Rules for Level two

1. *Swimmers are to stay home if they are unwell.*
2. *Alert Level 2 rules places a limit of 50 people in the building, this includes pool staff, spectators, swimmers, instructors and coaches. Parents are encouraged to ‘drop and run’ or sit in their cars.*
3. *Although the changing rooms are open swimmers are encouraged to arrive in their togs and go home wet!*
4. *Each family group (this being a swimmer on their own, or a swimmer and a parent) are to complete the council/pool’s contact tracing requirements – hopefully there is an I-pad in the pool entrance.*
5. *Swimmers are to bring their drink bottles to the pool FILLED.*
6. *Close contact between swimmers in the pool is allowed, but physical distancing of at least 2 metre poolside is to be observed out of the pool. Please remember this when interacting with the coach and pool staff.*
7. *Swimming bags are to put at the storeroom end of the pool and not mixed with any bags belonging to the public....applies to CCK At the Arena please leave your bags on the far side of the pool so that don’t get mixed up with the Public.*
8. *Masks are required to be worn outside of the pool if over 12 years of age.*
