## **Age Groups Points**

Points (8 for first, 5 for second, 3 for third and one to all other participants) are awarded in age groups from 6 yrs & under (separate age groups) through to 17yrs & over. Points accumulate and the top three boys and top three girls will receive age group medals. All age groups have an age group race in each stroke, plus a medley. Events available for age group points/races are shown in the column 'Ages eligible for Age Group Points'.

**Cups and Trophies** cover four strokes plus a medley in the double age groups shown. For most age groups there are five cups – four strokes plus a medley.

Important. The events as listed will be swum as timed finals with many events counting for the cups & trophies as well as age group points. For example – Results from Ev 22 Girls 100m breaststroke count towards the age group points for 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs 16yrs and 17yrs and over as well as the cups as listed.

The 25m event are eligible for age group points only.

## MEET CONDITIONS

- Meet is open to all financial members of Porirua City Aquatics.
- All events will be marshalled and swum as timed finals. (mixed ages, from slowest to fastest)
- Age is at the date of the meet.
- Warm Up; Entry to the pool during warm-up will be feet first only except at the start (deep) end in Lanes
  one and seven. These lanes will be available for diving and sprints for the duration of the warm up. There
  is to be no diving at the shallow end. ALL 25M RACES WILL START IN THE WATER AT THE SHALLOW END
- Entries will be via the SNZ Database. Entries close at midnight on Sunday 10 March 2023.
- There will be no entry fees, or door charges
- The Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage at this meet.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
- Strapping of muscles/joints is not permitted unless supported by a doctor or physio certificate and sighted by the Technical Director prior to the start of the session where strapping is applied.
- The Organisers reserve the right to amend the program if necessary, and to restrict entries.
- Meet will be run according to SNZ/World Aquatics and local rules. DQ's will be issued for rule
  infringements. This meet is not classed as a National Qualifying meet but will be officiated as such. Times
  achieved may be used as qualifying times for Regional Championships. Times may be used to break PCA
  short course records.
- By entering this meet participants agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swimming Wellington or PCA in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
- Parents of entrants must be available to assist at the meet as required.
