Come along and "HAVE A GO" – an introduction to racing.

Races are held in single age groups from 6 years and under up to 11 years and over, over 25m and 50m, in freestyle and backstroke only.

This meet is an introduction to racing, targeting swimmers newer club members and swimmers who have not raced in three or more zone or interclub events. All swimmers 8 years and under are considered 'Novice swimmers' and are eligible to enter. Swimmers 9 and over who have qualified to swim at the Wellington Champs may not enter. Events run with in our club for our club members only (race nights, Club Champs, In House league etc) are not counted as meets for eligibility.

Every effort will be made by the officials to put swimmers at ease and to ensure they enjoy their first swim meet. The club will appoint a team manager to look after the Porirua City Aquatics team at the meet. The team should sit together with the team manager. Parents should sit away from the team.

All those competing will receive a 'participant' ribbon. Swimmers will swim each event they enter once, and the times will be collated, should there be more than one

heat, to rank the swimmers – in swimming this is known as timed finals. Ribbons will be presented to those who place first, second or third overall in each event.

Full details and entry instructions are on the noticeboard and on the flyer which can be found on our website.

Club Sessions:

Monday 15 and 22 April will be devoted to distance badge swimming. Club and squad swimmers are welcome to join in.

Friday 19 April – Club swimming will be at the Arena – all swimmers will need to pay door entry at reception. Those who normally come at 6:00pm, and anyone younger than 9 years old, should come at 7:00pm.

Those who would normally come to a later group should come at 7.45pm.

Three lanes are booked from 7:00pm to 8:30pm. Tadpoles and Seals can come to either session.

We can't get the pool earlier as PCA's Seniors will be training. As some of our coaches will be away can parents step up and help. As we have three lanes this will allow for diving, but extra supervision is required to maintain safety.









Friday 26 April – swimming is cancelled as it is hoped the many club and junior squad swimmers will be entering PCA's Div III meet at the Tawa pool. See notice in this newsletter.

Distance Badges:

As many of you know PCA has distance badges swimmers can achieve by completing a distance without stopping, Distances covered are 25m (one length) 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, and 1500m. Once a swimmer has completed these distances they can move on to swimming 1 kilometer (40 lengths) for a time. PCA has a range of ribbons available to reward swimmers for times achieved.

On the two Mondays we will have half the pool until 6:30 pm and then the whole pool until 8:30 pm.

Swimming times – please come at the times set out below. It makes it very difficult when swimmers turn up at 6pm to swim 1K.

6:00 pm for those swimming distance badges for the first time.

6:45 pm for those swimming 200m, 400m, 800m and 1500m

7:15 pm for timed 1K swimmers

To help these evenings run smoothly our coaches will need help from parents counting laps and/or timing the 1k swimmers.

Please note:

swimmers may need to wait their turn if the lanes are full, to give everyone the opportunity to achieve their goals.

Parents helping are not to interrupt swimmers to update them on their progress or the number of lengths they have to go. Just leave them to get 'on with the job.' Hopefully they are counting themselves anyway!

Porirua City Aquatics Div III Meet:

Saturday 27 April 2024 Tawa Pool. Session one 9:00 am warm up for a 9:30 am start. Session 2 1:30 pm warm up for a 2:00 pm start.

This meet is open to all developing swimmers / up and coming swimmers, meaning swimmers who have qualified for the 2024 National Age Groups and Div II meet and/or NZ Opens may not enter the events they are nationally qualified to swim. Also those under 12 who were top finishers at Junior Festival and the Wellington Champs may not enter.

The flyer has times listed and normally these would be qualifying times, but for this meet if you swim **faster** than these times you can't enter.

The purpose of this meet is to give developing swimmers a chance to shine, win medals and gain finalist ribbons.

PCA has successfully run this meet for over 30 years and we will be expecting to have the biggest team there – it is a club fundraiser, and we also be expecting to see swimmers from all around the region, including Manawatu to enter as they have done in the past.

Entries, via SNZ database, close at midnight on 22 April 2024.

It is the PCA's expectation that our National swimmers (in club uniform) will help at the meet in return for the support they have received from the club to attend Nationals.

Swimming NZ Opens and National Age Groups (NAGs):

PCA's team of 10 swimmers had an extremely successful time at Swim Wellington's Scorching Bay Open Water Challenge with everyone winning a placing medal.

PCA was represented in three distances. 500m, 1.25k and 2.5k. All participant's received a participant medal, and then Gold, Silver and Bronze medals were presented to the first three male and females in the various age groups/distances..

Gold Cost Meet – Tawa – 18 February:

The thought of winning Chocolate and Ribbons for achieving a Personal Best or New Time was obviously the carrot our swimmers needed to enter this meet. PCA's team of 59 swimmers was one of the biggest we have ever had swim at a Gold Coast.

PCA came away with the Personal Best trophy with 66% of our swimmers achieving a PB, just ahead of Tawa with 65% and Raumati with 37%.

Away Meets:

Rebecca Yu achieved amazing results at the Auckland Junior Champs 1-3 March 2024.

Rebecca won the Gold Medals and broke the Wellington records in her three freestyle events. Her time in the 50m free of 28.84 broke the previous record of 29.30 set in 2019. Her 100m time of 1m02.02 broke the 2010 record of 1m05.20 and in 200m she swum 2m16.11 breaking the 2011 record of 2m19.81. She also took out a Gold medal in 50 butterfly and a Silber in 200 butterfly.

Meanwhile Lawrence Wang swum at the Manawatu Champs on the same weekend record 4 Personal Bests times in his eight events, placing Second in the 10 and under 100 freestyle and third in the 100m breaststroke.

Swim Wellington – Open Water Challenge:

PCA's coaches were to the fore at this open water swim held on 2nd March at Hataitai Beach, Evans Bay.

Distances covered 500m, 1.25ks, 2.5ks and 5ks, in three age groups - Juniors, up to 15yrs, Open, 16-34yrs and Masters, 35 plus.

Swimming in the Masters category Elouise Thomas won the Gold Medal for 500m while Matt Harrison won a Silver in the 1.25 swim.

The Harrison family had a very successful day with Emma winning Silver in the Junior 500m swim and Charlotte, the Gold medal for the Junior's 1.25k swim. Also to win Gold were Patrick Reiher, Juniors 1.25k, Joe Reiher Open 2.5k and Lauren Crawford, who braved the swim without a wetsuit to win the Gold in the Juniors 2.5k.

Justin Wang started his 2.5k powerfully without a wetsuit only to be beaten by the conditions.

Lincoln Thomas and Julia Wang both swam an excellent 500m race.

Thanks especially to Elouise who kept Lincoln company and then returned to the water to finish the race with Julia.

Swim Wellington National Qualifier:

Twenty two PCA swimmers took part in this National Qualifier Meet at the Kilbirnie Pool on 9 March.

National Qualifier meets, used to be called Tier one meets and are fully officiated enabling swimmers to break Wellington/NZ Records and use time recorded to qualify for National meets.

During the meet some amazing times were swum in the 400 freestyle with Maddy St Just taking 48.30 seconds off her time and Daniel Turetsky breaking his time by 18.20seconds.

Congratulations to the following, who broke club records during the meet. Lauren Crawford, 14yrs 1500 free, Alyssa Bai,12yrs 200 butterfly and Patrick Reiher, 12yrs 50 breaststroke. Patrick's was an impressive swim, with a time of 35.62 taking 0.90sec off the previous record set way back in 2009.

Subscriptions:

The membership year begins on 1 July, and subs for the year are:

- \$195.00 for club members. That is, those who swim in the Eels and Tadpoles squads and those who swim at the club sessions on Friday and/or Monday nights and/or Sunday mornings.
- \$150.00 for squad members, being those in the Senior squad, Orcas, Sharks, Swordfish, Seals and those who swim in PCA's Johnsonville squad.

Subs can be paid directly into the PCA bank account 030547-0205093-**00** – please use the swimmers name as a reference, or can be paid at the duty desk on a Monday or Friday night, or left in a named envelope in the black letterbox on our storeroom door.

Annual Subs are due on 1 July and should be paid as soon as possible.

For new members joining during the year the sub is prorated based on the month of joining, and if the swimmer is a squad or competitive swimmer. These rates are available from the Treasurer or the Committee Member on the desk on Monday and Friday club nights.

Swimmers are required to be financial members to enter swim meets and attend training nights (club and squad) and to attend and vote at the AGM or other club meetings.

Some leeway will be provided for the attendance at training as long as the annual sub is paid by 31 July, within four weeks of joining if a new member, or are on

an agreed payment plan and no payments have been missed.

There is no leeway for entering swim meets or being able to vote at club meetings. You must be a paid up member to participate in swim meets and club meetings.

PCA Swimming Caps:

New members will be given a cap on receipt of their first subscription payment.

Caps are replaced free of charge if they split, on presentation of the damaged cap.

The cost of caps are \$10 each if a swimmer requires another cap.

It would not normally be expected that any swimmer would need more than 1 or 2 caps each year.

Caps can be obtained from the sign-in desk at Monday and Friday night club sessions (at Cannons Creek) or the Team Manager at swim meets.
